Leave the study pool?

 You joined as a participant for studies in general, so this applies to **all** of them — there is no way to leave just one.

What happens

- **Chat about home energy** ends now — it is the one study you are currently in.
- You stop receiving invitations to new studies.
- You will not be added to studies that start later.

What stays

- Your account, so you can sign in whenever you like.
- The two studies you already finished, still readable.
- Everything you wrote. Nothing is deleted.

 **You can rejoin later.** Come back to Preferences and choose to rejoin — you will be eligible for studies that start after that. Studies that ended today will not restart.

Annotations

- Context: the enrollee's own pool-wide opt-out** The confirm shown by **Preferences** → **Leave the study pool**. It writes `profile.opted_out_at` and, in the same transaction, a `withdrawn_at` on every live `run_enrollment` the person holds. It is **pool-wide** because consent was pool-wide, **the enrollee's alone** (staff cannot opt somebody out; they suspend with enabled instead), and **reversible** — which is why it warns rather than guarding like a delete. See ALGORITHMS §28. You stop taking part in studies. Your account stays and nothing you already did is removed.
- Stay in the study pool.
- Leave the study pool now.
