- Read-only details** Opened from the row's View eye or the file name. A document is uploaded, then processed (Extract → Embed); this shows its metadata and status. The embedding chunks are internal and not shown here.
- Context documents are attached per run and shared with enrollees + models; reference documents are admin-managed and used by the Ask engine.
- Two-step pipeline** A document is usable once both steps finish: **Extract** pulls the text, **Embed** turns it into vectors. Only then can a run attach it or the Ask engine retrieve from it.
- Chunks are internal** The 14 embedding chunks are how retrieval works under the hood; they are not a user-facing list, so they are not shown here.
