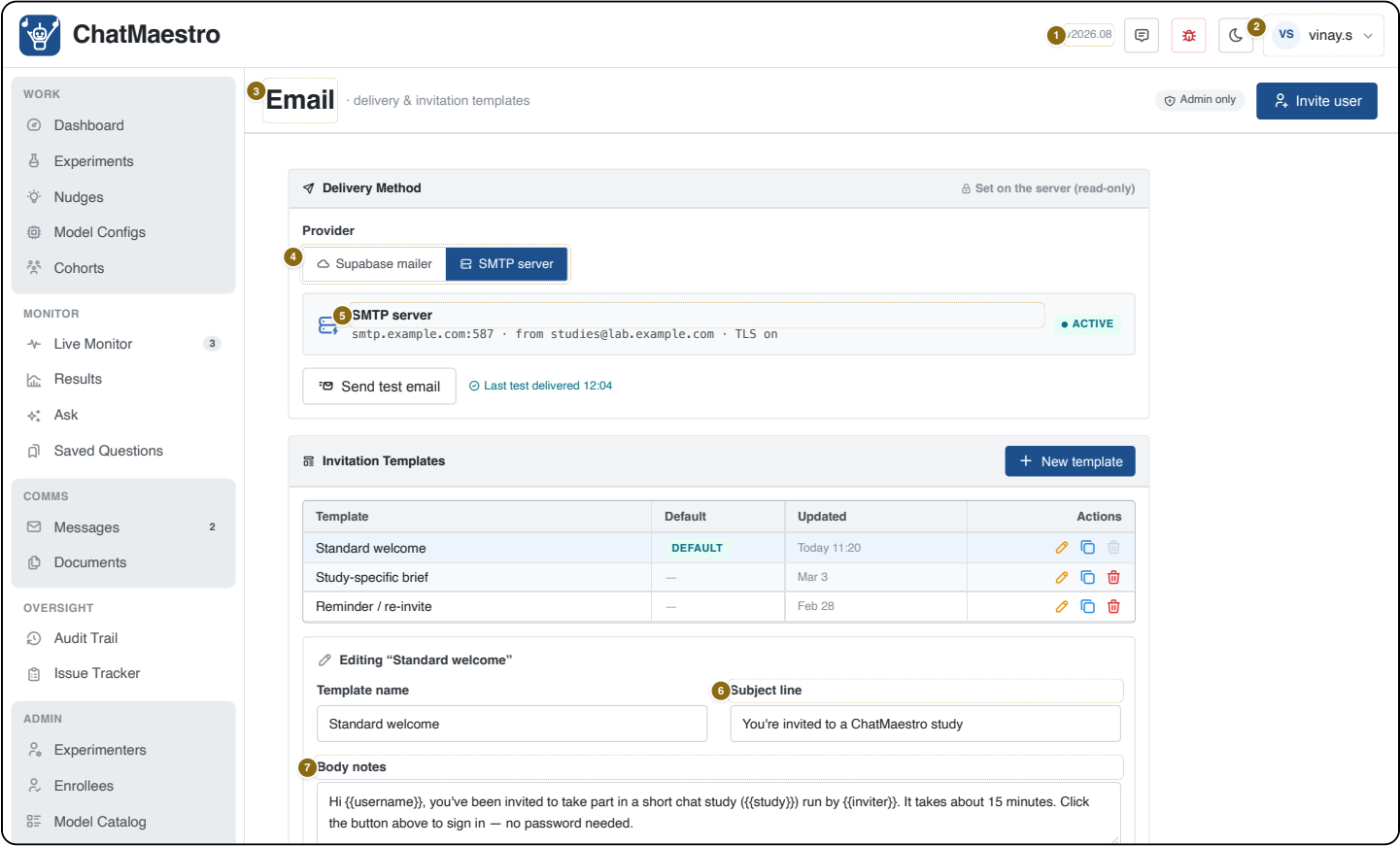

- 1

Version pill (right-aligned) Dimmed build pill sits on the RIGHT, beside the account menu. Hover reveals the build sha; on phones it folds into the account menu.

Account menu Avatar + name + chevron open the account menu (profile, settings, sign out). On narrow screens the feedback / bug / dark-mode icons and version pill collapse into here.

What this edits The custom text layered on top of Supabase’s standard invite template. Delivery itself is configured in the backend.
- 4

Set in the backend Provider (**Supabase** or **SMTP**) and all SMTP credentials are set once in the server .env / edge-function secrets, then redeployed — not editable here. Supabase’s built-in mailer is the fallback if SMTP is unset.

SMTP is the usual way an app sends email through a mail server.
- 6

Optional; if blank, Supabase's default subject is used.
- 7

Your extra text, added on top of Supabase's standard invite email.
- 8

Each {{tag}} is swapped for the real value when the email is sent.

- 9 **The permanent address** `{{app_url}}` is bound from the mandatory APP_URL install setting. It is required in every enrollee-facing template and does a different job from `{{invite_link}}`: the link is a first-entry convenience that expires after INVITE_LINK_EXPIRY_HOURS (72 by default), while this is where the person signs in for the rest of the study. Without it the natural thing to do is bookmark the link, and an enrollee returning a week later finds a dead credential and reasonably concludes they are locked out (ALGORITHMS §22). The permanent web address of this installation — where people sign in after the invite link expires.

- 10 **Concurrent-edit safety (OCC)** Save issues a **versioned write** through the middle tier — `UPDATE ... SET ..., version = version + 1 WHERE id = ... AND version = (the value this form loaded)`. If someone saved this template first, no row matches and the save is refused: the screen shows **“This record changed since you opened it — reload”** instead of silently overwriting their edit.
