Leave the study pool

You joined as a participant for studies in general, so leaving applies to all of them. Any study you are in now ends, you stop receiving invitations, and you will not be added to new ones. Your account stays, your finished studies stay readable, and you can rejoin later.

 Leave the study pool

1 Enrollee-scoped preferences A participant sees a small, safe subset of preferences — appearance and their own notifications. Everything experiment-related (studies, prompts, models) is set by the researcher and is not shown here.

2 Your email is managed by the research team and can't be changed here.

3 Pool-wide, and the enrollee's alone Writes `profile.opted_out_at`. It is **pool-wide** because the consent was: an enrollee accepts an invitation to the pool, not to a named study, and studies reach them afterward through cohort membership — so a per-study refusal would decline something they were never separately asked about. Opting out withdraws them from every live run in one transaction (each `run_enrollment` takes a `withdrawn_at`), stops further `run_ready` mail, and removes them from cohort resolution so a later launch cannot re-enroll them. Distinct from `profile.enabled`, which is a suspension staff apply. Everything they produced stays and still counts, and the decision is reversible (see [ALGORITHMS §28](#)). Stop taking part in studies. You keep your account, and anything you already did stays as it is.

4 Leave the study pool. You will be asked to confirm.

5 Discard changes and go back.

6 Save your preference settings.
