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Annotations

- Version pill (right-aligned)** Dimmed build pill sits on the RIGHT, beside the account menu. Hover reveals the build sha; on phones it folds into the account menu.
- Owner filter** Narrow the list to nudges you or a teammate own. Peers can still browse everyone's nudges and reuse them in a run — but only the owner can edit or delete one.
- New nudge** Opens the nudge editor. Owners create, edit, and delete their own nudges; peers get read access plus 'use in a run' when composing an experiment — so a nudge is shared vocabulary, authored by one person.
- Confined horizontal scroll** The scrollbar belongs to THIS viewport — only the middle Steering-text column scrolls. The Select and Nudge columns stay pinned left and Actions stays pinned right, so a row's identity and its controls never scroll away.
- What a nudge is** A nudge is a reusable, named, enrollee-safe steering message. A study varies nudges across its runs the way it varies cohorts and model configs — so you can compare, say, 'concise' vs 'thorough' steering under otherwise identical conditions. The name is the pinned identity; the dimmed line under it previews the steering text.
- The exact message shown to the enrollee, truncated here to one line. The full text — and how it renders in a chat — lives in the nudge editor.
- Used by → immutability** Counts the runs that reference this nudge. Once a nudge is used by a run its text is FROZEN so past results stay reproducible — edit and delete are disabled. Clone it (always allowed) to make a changed version.

- 8 **Immutable while referenced** Edit is disabled because a run already uses this nudge — changing its text would rewrite past results. Clone (always enabled, to the right) is how you evolve a referenced nudge into a new, editable one.
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- 9 Clone is always enabled. Cloning a referenced nudge is how you make a changed version without touching the runs — and the results — that already depend on the original.
