 **Annotations**

1

Version pill (right-aligned) Dimmed build pill sits on the RIGHT, beside the account menu. Hover reveals the build sha; on phones it folds into the account menu.

2

Account menu Avatar + name + chevron open the account menu (profile, settings, sign out). On narrow screens the feedback / bug / dark-mode icons and version pill collapse into here.

3

Every saved question, at every trust level. Review drafts, approve the good ones, and take a shared button back when it stops earning its place.

4

One screen, two views This is the admin’s copy: every n_l_query row at every status — **draft** (private to its owner), **approved** (everyone in scope gets the button), **built-in** (shipped) — retired ones included. An experimenter opens the same screen and row-level security shows them only their own drafts, drafts shared with them, and the approved and built-in questions that are not retired (see *Saved questions* under Experimenter).

5

Retired questions are listed only here; they never appear on an Ask surface.

6

The button caption, its full question underneath, and a note icon when someone has written notes about it (hover to read). View shows the SQL it runs; you can’t edit the SQL here.

7

Reuse flags candidates Frequently-reused drafts (high hit_count) are flagged as candidates to make official.

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- 8 **Status badge = status + retired_at** **draft**, **approved** and **built-in** are `n1_query.status`. A second **retired** badge means `retired_at` is set: still approved, but hidden from Ask until restored. Editing an approved or built-in question is admin-only; owners keep their own drafts.

- 9 Five slots: View · Approve or Unapprove · Edit · Retire or Restore (approved questions only) · Delete. Built-ins can only be viewed and edited.

- 10 **Approve — one field, one note** Reused 214 times by 7 people. Approving flips status to **approved** and moves it out of the owner's private drafts into everyone's Results Ask. The optional note is appended to `n1_query.notes`, stamped with who and when, and copied into the `audit_log` row. Optional note — kept with the question and in the activity log.

- 11 **Unapprove — the way back** status goes from **approved** back to **draft**: the owner may edit it again and the button leaves everyone else's Ask at their next load. Logged to `audit_log`.

- 12 **Retire = soft delete** Sets `retired_at`; the row, its SQL, its use count and its notes stay. Hidden from every Ask surface and from matching until an admin clicks **Restore**. Admin-only, approved questions only — the undoable alternative to Delete, which sits beside it and is permanent.

- 13 **Restore undoes Retire** Clears `retired_at`. Nothing else changed while it was parked, so the button comes back exactly as it was. **Delete** stays available on a retired row too, and is the permanent step.
