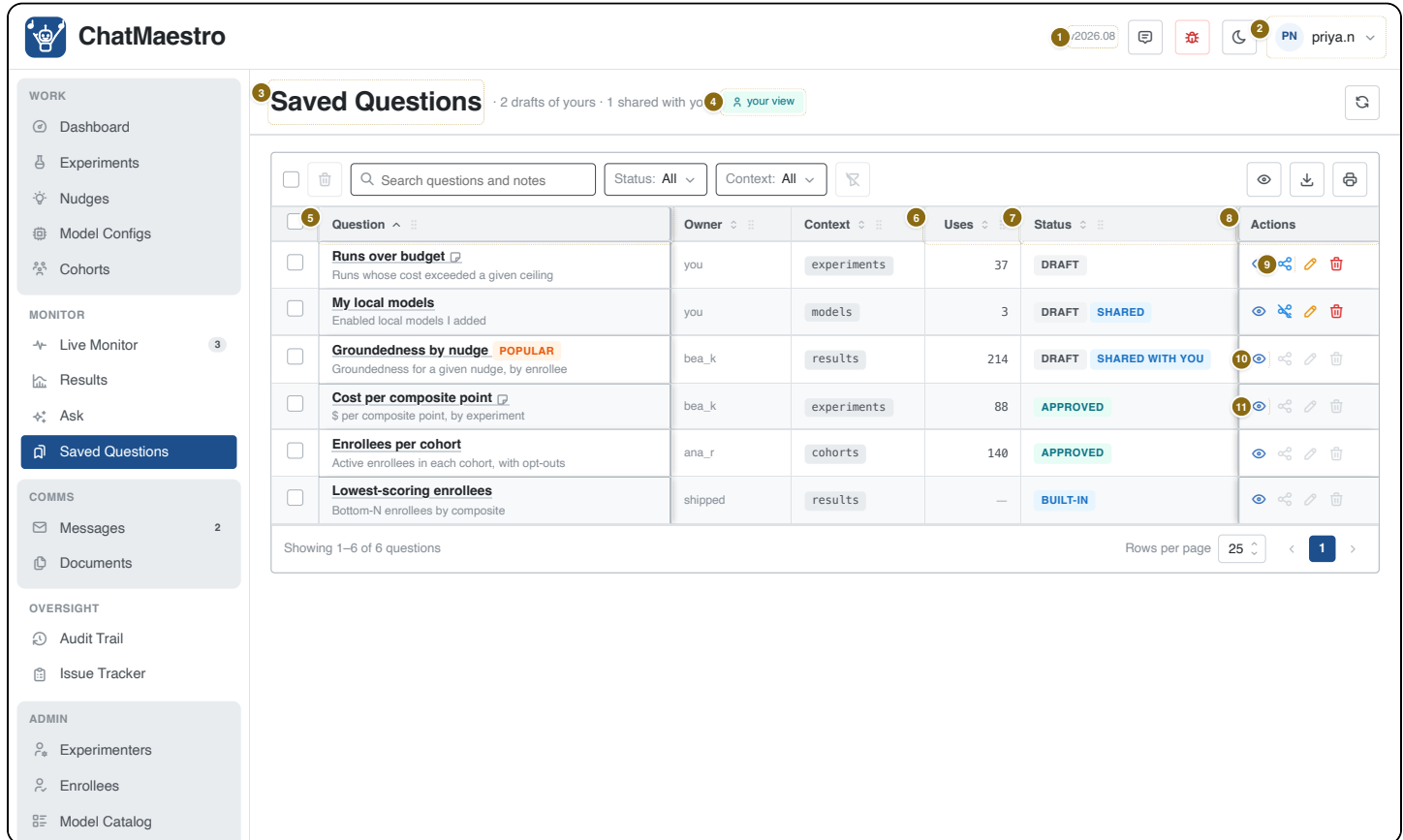

Annotations

- 1 Version pill (right-aligned)** Dimmed build pill sits on the RIGHT, beside the account menu. Hover reveals the build sha; on phones it folds into the account menu.
- 2 Account menu** Avatar + name + chevron open the account menu (profile, settings, sign out). On narrow screens the feedback / bug / dark-mode icons and version pill collapse into here.
- 3** The questions you saved from Ask, the drafts teammates shared with you, and the team's approved buttons. Edit, share or delete your own; the rest is read-only.
- 4 One screen, two views** This is the experimenter's copy of the same screen an admin uses. Row-level security on `n1_query` lists your own drafts, drafts shared with you, and the approved and built-in questions — never a retired one, never another person's private draft. Only your own drafts are editable; approving, unapproving, retiring and restoring are admin actions (see *Saved questions* under Admin).
- 5** The button caption, its full question underneath, and a note icon when there are notes (hover to read). View shows the SQL it runs.
- 6** How often the question has been run, by anyone who can see it.
- 7** draft = yours (or shared with you), approved = a team button, built-in = shipped with the install.
- 8** View · Share or stop sharing · Edit · Delete — the last three only on your own drafts.

- 9 **Your drafts are yours** Row-level security lists a draft only for its owner unless `is_shared` is on, which lets teammates see and run it read-only. You keep the only edit rights, and you can delete it; approving it into a shared button is an admin's call on the same screen.

- 10 **A teammate's shared draft** You see it because `bea_k` turned on `is_shared`. You can run it from Ask and read its SQL [here](#); you cannot edit, share or delete it.
-
- 11 **Approved questions are read-only [here](#)** An approved question is everyone's button and only an admin edits, unapproves or retires it. A retired one is not listed for you at all — it is hidden from Ask and from this table until an admin restores it.
